



## **PAINTING YOUR FAVORITE PET**

### **A two-day Workshop with Adeline Halvorson**

Saturday, June 17 and Sunday, June 18 from 10 am – 4 pm  
At Paul Perron's Shop/Studio just 15 minutes west of Saskatoon

In this workshop you will learn to paint an oil portrait of your chosen pet in a realistic style (students usually choose a dog, cat or a horse but other animals with fur will be considered). You will work from a photo that you provide to paint a portrait that you will be proud to display. Adeline will preview your reference photo to ensure it is suitable and to prepare your individual lesson plan.

The two day workshop will walk you through the process, even if you have very limited skills or little experience with painting. The class is open to all levels.

The \$225.00 fee includes some but not all supplies. You can share the brushes that are there, or bring your own. You may wish to bring your own oil paints if you have them. Or you can opt to have Adeline supply paint and canvas for an additional \$25 fee. Please look over the materials list and bring the items you can from this list.

Adeline will be using water soluble oil paints. If you have your own oil paint (does not have to be water soluble), please note that there will be **no cadmium** colours allowed in the class due to a previous health issue. We will also not allow any solvents and no mediums other than the ones stated. Since oil paints dry slowly, you will be able to clean your brushes at home when you are finished or Adeline will do the final cleaning of the brushes she supplies. Please bring a container or plastic bag to transport your brushes home. You will not need any turpentine or solvent during the painting process.

## Workshop Materials

The water soluble oil paints and 9x12" canvas will be provided at a charge of \$25 or you can opt to bring your own.

Paints – you can bring your own oil, or share the water soluble oils available at the workshop:

### Colours:

- Titanium White
- Pyrrole Red
- Burnt Sienna
- Ultramarine Blue
- Permanent Yellow Light
- Turquoise Blue

### Optional Colours:

- Light Oxide Red
- Vermillion
- Blue Violet
- Permanent Red Violet Light

**NO CADMIUM COLOURS due to health concerns**

Brushes –there will be some available to share at the workshop, but you may prefer to bring your own; that way you are sure to have the one you want when you need it.

- at least 2 or 3 of each size of Hogs Hair Filbert Bristle brushes – sizes 1, 2, and 4
- 1 or 2 of the size 6
- 2 or 3 of each size of Princeton 6200F synthetic brushes – sizes 1, 2, and 4. The 6300 is a bit stiffer, but would work as well. (Hues carries 6300 but not 6200)

You will also need:

- Q-tips (very important)
- palette knife for mixing your paint (there will be some there to share)
- a disposable strip palette (12x16" or 16x20" – or the one you usually use)
- fine tipped black marker (Sharpie)
- Linseed oil or other no odour painting medium
- Scissors
- a ruler
- Scotch tape
- Paper towel
- Container with rice (to hold your brushes)
